

NOTIFICATION NO. 5013-5206-M-XIII, dated the 21st NOVEMBER 1951.

Rule providing for the division of the city of Nagpur into wards
and for the number of councillors to be elected for each ward.

(Under Section 10 read with section 420 (2) (h))

The City shall be divided into wards as described below and each ward shall elect one councillor to the Corporation :—

DESCRIPTION OF BOUNDARIES

NO. 1. DHANTOLI WARD

North—Along the northern bank of the Nag River eastwards from Jail Road up to the bridge on Humpyard Road; then further eastwards up to the western side fencing of the G. I. P. Railway.

South—Along the southern limits of Humpyard Road eastwards and north-eastwards from Jail Road up to railway over-bridge.

East—Along the western side of the G. I. P. Railway fencing southwards from Nag River up to the Humpyard Road at the railway over-bridge.

West—Along the eastern limits of Jail Road southwards from Nag River up to Humpyard Road.

NO. 2 SANGAM WARD

North—Along the northern limits of Mahatma Gandhi Road eastwards from Jail Road up to Somwar Bazar Road; then southwards along the eastern limits of Somwar Bazar Road up to Malviya Road; then eastwards and north-eastwards along the southern and eastern limits of Malviya Road up to south-west corner of the railway bridge.

South—Northern boundary of Dhantoli Ward.

East—Along the western fencing of G. I. P. Railway southwards from the south-west corner of the railway bridge up to Nag River.

West—Along the eastern limits of Jail Road southwards from the Mahatma Gandhi Road up to Nag River.

NO. 3. SITABULDI WARD

North—Along the northern limits of Ansari Road eastwards from Jail Road up to the point it meets the western side fencing of the G. I. P. Railway crossing the Hislop Road.

South—Northern boundary of Sangam Ward.

East—Along the western fencing of the G. I. P. Railway southwards from the north-east corner of this ward up to railway bridge; further in straight line up to south-west corner of the bridge.

West—Along the eastern limit of the Jail Road southwards from Ansari Road up to Mahatma Gandhi Road.

NO. 4. FACTORY WARD.

North—Along the northern limits of Subhash Chandra Road eastwards from the north-west corner of railway bridge up to Umrer Road.

South—Along the northern bank of the Nag River eastwards from western fencing of G. I. P. Railway up to the south-west corner of the Model Mills Compound.

East—Along the eastern limits of Umrer Road southwards from the Subhash Chandra Road up to Abhyankar Smarak Road; then westwards along the southern limits of Abhyankar Smarak Road up to Ganeshpeth Road No. I; further southwards along the western limits of Ganeshpeth Road No. I up to the fencing of the Model Mills' Chawls; then westwards and southwards along this fencing up to the compound wall of Model Mills; further southwards along the western compound of Model Mills straight up to the Nag River.

West—Eastern boundary of Sangam Ward.

NO. 5. MODEL MILLS WARD

North—Along the southern limits of Abhyankar Smarak Road eastwards from Ganeshpeth Road No. I up to Umrer Road; then northwards along the eastern limits of Umrer Road up to Tilak Road to the north of Tilak Statue; then eastwards along the northern limits of Tilak Road up to New Shukrawari Road.

South—Along the northern bank of Nag River eastwards from the point near south-west corner of Model Mills compound up to the bridge on Umrer Road.

East—Along the eastern limits of New Shukrawari Road southwards from Tilak Road up to the bridge on Nag River.

West—Eastern boundary of Factory Ward.

NO. 6. JAT TARODI WARD

North—Southern boundary of Factory Ward and Model Mills Ward.

South—Along the northern limits of Rajabaxa Road eastwards and northeastwards from the western fencing of G. I. P. Railway near over-bridge up to the bridge on Nag River on Umrer Road.

West—Eastern boundary of Dhantoli Ward.

NO. 7. SIRASPETH WARD

North—Along the northern bank of Nag River eastwards from the bridge on Nag River on Umrer Road up to the point it meets the bridge on Old Shukrawari Road.

South—Along the northern limits of road by the side of G. I. P. Railway Colony fencing eastwards and southwards from Rajabaxa Road up to Outer Ring Road; then along the northern limits of the road up to Manewada Road; further eastwards in straight line up to the junction of Umrer Road and Old Shukrawari Road.

East Along the eastern limits Old Shukrawari Road south-wards from the Nag River up to the point it meets Umrer Road.

West—Southern boundary of Jat Tarodi Ward.

NO. 8. BABULKHEDA WARD

North—Southern boundaries of Dhantoli Ward, part of Jat Tarodi Ward and Siraspeth Ward.

South—Along the southern boundary of village Chichbhuwan eastwards from Wardha Road up to the junction of villages Chichbhuwan, Khapri and Shankarapur; then along the eastern boundary of villages Chichbhuwan and Somalwada, northwards up to the junction of villages Somalwada, Babulkheda and Bel Tarodi; then along the southern boundary of villages Babulkheda and Manewada eastwards up to the junction of villages Manewada, Chikhali and Pipla.

East—Along the southern limits of Umrer Road south-east-wards from Old Shukrawari Road up to the boundary of village Sakardara; then along the northern boundary of village Sakardara westwards up to junction of villages Sakardara, Babulkheda and Jat Tarodi; then along the eastern boundary of village Babulkheda southwards up to junction of village Sakardara Babulkheda and Manewada; then along the northern boundary of village Manewada southwards and eastwards up to the junction of villages Chikhali, Manewada and Sakardara; then along the eastern boundary of village Manewada up to the junction of villages Manewada, Chikhali and Pipla.

West—Along the eastern limits of Wardha Road southwards from Humpyard Road up to the southern boundary of village Chichbhuwan.

NO. 9 MAHAL WARD

North.—Along the northern limits of Tilak Road eastwards from New Shukrawari Road up to the Mahal-Itwari Road.

South.—Along the northern bank of Nag River eastwards from the bridge on Umrer Road up to the point it meets the Nallah on the eastern side of Tulsibagh.

East.—Along the eastern limits of Tulsibagh Road southwards from Tilak Road up to the point it meets the fencing of Tulsibagh; further eastwards along this fencing up to the Nallah on north east corner of Tulsibagh; then southwards along the eastern bank of this Nallah up to Nag River.

West.—Eastern boundary of Model Mills Ward.

NO. 10. CHITNAVISPURA WARD

North.—Along the northern limits of Shankar Street eastwards from Mahal Chawk up to the point it meets the bridge on Nallah near Gangaghat.

South.—Along the northern bank of Nag River eastwards and northwards from the Nallah running along the eastern fencing of Tulsibagh up to the Nallah near Gangaghat.

East.—Along the eastern limits of Nallah coming from Mangalwari southwards from the bridge on Shankar street up to the Nag River.

West.—Eastern boundary of Mahal Ward.

NO. 11 SAKARDARA WARD

North.—Along the northern limits of Old Bagadganj Road from the bridge on Nallah on Shankar Street up to the Glass Factory Road; then along the eastern limits of Glass Factory Road (Lakadganj Precinct) northwards up to Bhandara Road; then along the southern limits of Bhandara Road eastwards up to the eastern boundary of village Bhandewadi.

South.—Along the southern boundary of village Chikhali eastwards from the junction of villages Manerla, Chikhali, Pipla up to the junction of villages Chikhali, Pipla and Hudakeshwar; then along the eastern boundary of village Chikhali northwards up to the junction of villages Chikhali, Bidpeth and Hudakeshwar; then along the southern boundaries of villages Bidpeth and Dighori eastwards up to the junction of villages Dighori, Kharbi and Gondhani.

East.—Along the eastern boundary of village Bhandewadi southwards from Bhandara Road up to the junction of villages Wathoda, Bhandewadi and Bidgaon; then along the eastern and southern boundary of villages Wathoda southwards then westwards up to the junction of village Wathoda, Dighori and Kharbi; then along the eastern boundary of village Dighori southwards up to the junction of villages Dighori, Kharbi and Gondhani.

West.—Eastern boundaries of Siraspeth Ward and Babulkheda Ward.

NO. 12. MANGALWARI WARD

North.—Along the eastern limits of Gangajamna Road eastwards and northwards from Ayachit Bridge up to Old Mangalwari Road; then along the northern limits of Old Mangalwari Road eastwards up to Koshtipura Road; then along the northern limits of Koshtipura Road eastwards up to Nallah near Gandli's house; then along the eastern limits of this Nallah northwards up to Central Avenue Road (Lakadganj Precinct); then along the northern limits of Central Avenue Road eastwards up to Glass Factory Road.

South.—Along the northern limits of Old Bagadganj Road (Shankar Street) from Nawabpura Road up to Glass Factory Road.

East.—Along the eastern limits of Glass Factory Road southwards from Central Avenue Road up to Old Bagadganj Road.

West.—Eastern boundary of Budhwar Bazar Ward.

NO. 13. BUDHWAR BAZAR WARD

North.—Along the northern limits of Walker Road eastwards from Itwari-Mahal Road up to the point it meets the south-east corner of the Ayachit Bridge.

South.—Northern boundary of Chitnavispura Ward.

East.—Along the western limits of Nawabpura Road south eastwards from Ayachit Bridge up to Shankar Street.

West.—Along the eastern limits of Mahal-Itwari Road southwards from Walker Road up to Mal Chawk.

NO. 14. KOTWALI WARD.

North.—Along the southern limits of Central Avenue Road eastwards from Panchpaoli Road up to Budhukhan Minara Road; further along the southern limits of Jalpa Road eastwards from the above point up to the point it meets the Sewer Line; further eastwards along the Sewer Line up to Jaganath Road.

South.—Along the northern limits of Tilak Road eastwards from Panchapaoli Road up to Mahal Chawk.

East.—Along the eastern limits of Jaganath Road southwards from the Sewer Line up to Itwari-Mahal Road; further along the eastern limits of Itwari Mahal Road, southwards up to Mahal Chawk.

West.—Along the eastern limits of Panchpaoli Road southwards from the Central Avenue Road up to Tilak Road.

NO. 15. SHUKRAWAR TALAO WARD

North.—Along the northern limits of Empress Mills Road eastwards and northwards from the eastern G. I. P. Railway fencing up to Jamnadas Road; then along the northern limits of Jamanadas Road eastwards up to the bridge on Nallah near Ganjipeth Chawk; then along the eastern bank of this Nallah northwards up to the culvert on Santra Market Road; then along the northern limits of the Santra Market Road eastwards up to Hakimji Lane then along the northern limits of Hakimji Lane south-eastwards up to Telipura Road; further along the northern limits of Telipura Road up to Panchpaoli Road.

South.—Along the northern boundary of Factory Ward from the eastern railway fencing up to Umrer Road; further along the northern boundary or Model Mills Ward.

East.—Along the eastern limits of Panchpaoli Road southwards from Telipura Road up to Tilak Road.

West.—Along the eastern G. I. P. Railway fencing southwards from Empress Mills Road up to Subhash Chandra Road.

NO. 16. SANTRA MARKET WARD

North.—Along the southern limits of Bhandara Road eastwards from the eastern G. I. P. Railway fencing near the over-bridge up to the Nallah beyond Hansapuri Road.

South.—Northern boundary of Shukarwar Talao Ward between eastern G. I. P. Railway fencing and Ganjipeth Chawk.

East.—Along the eastern limits of Nallah southwards from Bhandara Road up to Ganjipeth Chawk.

West.—Along the eastern G. I. P. Railway fencing southwards from the over-bridge up to Empress Mills Road.

NO. 17. TAHSIL WARD.

North.—Along the southern limits of Bhandara Road eastwards from the north-east corner of Santra Market Ward up to Panchpaoli Road.

South.—Northern boundary of Shukrawar Talao Ward between Ganjipeth Chawk and Panchpaoli Road.

East.—Along the eastern limits of Panchpaoli Road southwards from Bhandara Road up to Telipura Road.

West.—Eastern boundary of Santra Market Ward between Bhandara Road and Santra Market Road.

NO. 18. NAMAK GANJ WARD.

North.—Along the southern limits of Bhandara Road eastwards from Panchpaoli Road up to Itwari Chawk.

South.—Northern boundary of Kotwali Ward between Panchpaoli Road and Jaganath Road; further southwards along the eastern limits of Jaganath Road up to Walker Road near Badkas Chawk.

East.—Along the eastern limits of Itwari-Mahal Road southwards from Itwari Chawk up to Walker Road.

West.—Along the eastern limits of Panchpaoli Road southwards from Bhandara Road up to Central Avenue Road.

NO. 19. AYACHIT MANDER WARD.

North.—Along the northern limits of Nikalas Mandir Road eastwards from Itwari-Mahal Road up to Ayachit Road; then southwards along the eastern limits of Ayachit Road up to Chawk in front of Avadhoot Mandir; further eastwards along the northern limits of Dokebowa Math Road up to Gangajamna Road.

South.—Northern boundary of Budhwar Bazar Road.

East.—Along the eastern limits of Gangajamna Road southwards and westwards from Dokebowa Math Road up to the southwest corner of Ayachit Bridge.

West.—Along the eastern limits of Itwari-Mahal Road southwards from Nikalas Mandir Road up to Walker Road.

NO. 20. CHINTESHWAR TEMPLE WARD.

North.—Along the southern limits of Bhandara Road eastwards from Gangajamna Road up to the junction of Old Service Road of B. N. Railway.

South.—Northern boundary of Mangalwari Ward between Gangajamna Road and Nallah.

East.—Along the eastern limits of the lane southwards from the junction of Bhandara Road and Old Service Road near Chitnavis Chawl upto 30ft. road of the Improvement Trust; then along the northern limits of the same road south-westwards up to the junction with 80' road; then along the western limits of 30' road south-eastwards up to Central Avenue Road (Lakadganj Precinct); further along the northern limits of Central Avenue Road westwards up to the Nallah; then along the eastern limits of this Nallah southwards up to the junction with Kostipura Road near Gandli's House.

West.—Along the eastern limits of Gangajamna Road southwards from Bhandara Road up to Old Mangalwari Road.

NO. 21. ITWARI WARD

North.—Along the northern limits of Craddock Road eastwards from Kirana Oli up to Itwari Station Road; then along the eastern limits of Itwari Station Road northwards up to southern fencing of B. N. Railway; then along this fencing eastwards up to eastern limits of Old Service Road of B. N. Railway.

South.—Northern boundary of Ayachit Mandir Ward.

East.—Along the eastern limits of Old Service Road of B. N. Railway southwards from B. N. Railway fencing up to Bhandara Road; then along the southern limits of Bhandara Road westwards up to Gangajamna Road; then along the eastern limits of Gangajamna Road southwards up to Dokebowa Math Road.

West.—Along the eastern limits of Kirana Oli southward from Craddock Road up to Bhandara Road; then along the eastern limits of Itwari-Mahal Road southwards from Bhandara Road up to Nikalas Mandir Road.

NO. 22. BAGADGANJ WARD

North.—Along the northern limits of Old Kamptee Road north eastwards from railway over-bridge up to northern fencing of B. N. Railway (Calcutta Line); then along the northern and western fencing of this Railway Line eastwards and northwards up to the northern boundary of Village Kalamna.

South.—Northern boundary of Mangalwari Ward along Central Avenue Road up to Glass Factory Road (Lakadganj Precinct); then along the northern boundary of Sakardara Ward.

East.—Along the eastern boundaries of villages Kalamna, Punapur, Bharatwada Bhandewadi southwards from the northern fencing of B. N. Railway (Calcutta Line) up to Bhandara Road.

West.—Along the eastern limits of Itwari Station Road southwards from the north-west corner of railway over-bridge near Itwari Station up to southern fencing of B. N. Railway; then along this fencing eastwards up to eastern limits of old Service Road of B. N. Railway; then along the eastern boundary of Itwari Ward up to Bhandara Road; then along the eastern boundary of Chinteshwar Temple Ward up to Central Avenue Road.

NO. 23. LALGANG WARD.

North.—Along the northern limits of Itwari Station Road eastwards from Mehadibagh Road up to Old Mehadibagh Road; then along the western limits of the same road northwards up to Bastarwari Road; then along the northern limits of the Bastarwari Road; then along the northern limits of Bastarwari Road eastwards up to the point where it meets the Metal Road coming from Panch Temple; then along the northern limits of the Metal Road south-eastwards across the Nallah up to Old Kamptee Road.

South.—Along the northern limits of Craddock Road eastwards from Mehadibagh Road up to Station Road.

East.—Along the northern limits of Old Kamptee Road southwestwards from the Metal Road near Panch Temple up to Railway bridge; then along the western limits of Station Road southwards up to Craddock Road.

West.—Along the eastern limits of Mehadibagh Road southwards from Itwari Station Road up to Craddock Road.

NO. 24. MEHADIBAGH WARD.

North.—Along the southern limits of Kamptee Road northeastwards from Lalganj Road (Panchpaoli Housing Accommodation Scheme) up to the point it meets the northern boundary of village Wanjara across the B. N. Railway (Chhindwara Line); then along the northern boundaries of villages Wanjara and Kalamna eastwards from Kamptee Road up to Western fencing of B. N. Railway (Calcutta Line).

South.—Along the northern limits of the lane running over Sewer Line eastward from the bridge on Nallah up to the bridge on Lendi Talao; then along the northern limits of bund eastwards from the bridge up to the road leading to Mehadibagh Road; then along the northern limits of this road, eastwards, southwards and again eastwards up to Mehadibagh Road; then along the eastern limits of Mehadibagh Road up

to Itwari Station Road; further along the northern boundary of Lalganj Ward.

East.—Northern boundary of Bagadganj Ward between northern boundary of village Kalamna and Old Kamptee Road up to Panch Temple.

West.—Along the eastern limits of New Lalganj Road (Panchpaoli Housing Accommodation Scheme) south-eastwards from Kamptee Road up to Chamar Nallah canalisation; then along the eastern limits of Mang Nallah up to the bridge on Sewer Line.

NO. 25. RESHIM BAZAR WARD.

North.—Southern boundary of Mehadibagh Ward between Mang Nallah and Mehadibagh Road.

South.—Along the southern limits of Bhandara Road eastwards from Jagnath Road up to Itwari Chwk.

East.—Along the eastern limits of Mehadibagh Road southwards from Itwari Station Road up to Craddock Road; then along the eastern limits of Kirana Oli southwards up to Itwari-Mahal Road.

West.—Along the eastern limits of Mang Nallah southwards from the bridge of Sewer Line up to northern fencing of B. N. Railway (Itwari Line) then eastwards along the northern fencing of B. N. Railway up to Jagnath Road; further southwards along the eastern limits of Jaganath Road up to Bhandara Road.

NO. 26. JAGNATH MANDIR WARD.

North.—Along the southern fencing of B. N. Railway (Calcutta Line) eastwards from Panchpaoli Road near Police Lines up to Mang Nallah.

South.—Along the southern limits of Bhandara Road eastwards from Panchpaoli Road up to Jagnath Road.

East.—Western boundaries of Mehadibagh Ward and Reshim Bazar Ward between B. N. Railway (Calcutta Line) and the Bhandara Road.

West.—Along the eastern limits of Panchpaoli Road southwards from B. N. Railway fencing near Police Line up to Bhandara Road.

NO. 27. GOLIBAR WARD.

North.—Along the southern fencing of B. N. Railway (Itwara Line) eastwards from Timki Road up to Panchpaoli Road.

South.—Along the southern limits of Bhandara Road eastwards from Timki Road up to Panchpaoli Road.

East.—Along the eastern limits of Panchpaoli Road southwards from the southern railway fencing of B. N. Railway (Itwara Line) up to Bhandara Road.

West.—Along the eastern limits of Timki Road southwards from B. N. Railway foot-bridge upto Bhandara Road.

NO. 28. WINKAR WARD.

North.—Along the northern limits of Craddock Road eastwards from Mohammad Ali Road up to Timki Road.

South.—Along the southern limits of Bhandara Road eastwards from Mohammad Ali Road up to Timki Road.

East.—Along the eastern limits of Timki Road southwards from Craddock Road up to Bhandara Road.

West.—Along the eastern limits of Mohammad Ali Road southwards from Craddock Road up to Bhandara Road.

NO. 29. MAYO HOSPITAL WARD.

North.—Along the southern fencing of B. N. Railway eastwards from the underbridge up to north-east corner of Burial Ground.

South.—Along the southern limits of Bhandara Road eastwards from G. I. P. Railway over-bridge up to Mohammad Ali Road.

East.—Along the eastern fencing of Burial Ground southwards and westwards from the B. N. Railway fencing up to the Kabarasthan Road; then along the eastern limits of Kabarasthan Road southwards up to the culvert on the same road; then eastwards along the northern limits of Boulder Road and further through the lane up to Bhankheda Road; then southwards along the eastern limits of Bhankheda Road up to Rambhaji Road; further eastwards along the northern limits of Rambhaji Road up to Timki Road; further southwards along the eastern limits of Timki Road up to Craddock Road; then westwards along the northern limits of Craddock Road up to Mohammad Ali Road; then southwards along the boundary of Winkar Ward.

West.—Along the eastern fencing of G. I. P. Railway southwards from the under-bridge up to G. I. P. Railway over-bridge on Bhandara Road.

NO. 30. BHANKHEDA WARD.

North.—Along the southern fencing of B. N. Railway (Calcutta Line) eastwards from the bifurcation up to Panchpaoli Road near Police Lines.

South.—Along the eastern boundary of Mayo Hospital Ward between Kabarasthan Road and Timki Road; further northwards along the eastern limits of Timki Road up to B. N. Railway fencing (Itwara Line); then eastwards along the southern fencing of B. N. Railway up to Panchpaoli Road.

East.—Along the eastern limits of Panchpaoli Road southwards from B. N. Railway fencing (Calcutta Line) near Police Line up to southern fencing of B. N. Railway (Itwara Line).

West.—Along the eastern limits of the Nallah southwards from the culvert near bifurcation on B. N. Railway (Calcutta Line) up to southern fencing of B. N. Railway (Itwara Line); then westwards along the same fencing up to the north-east corner of Burial Ground; further along the eastern boundary of Mayo Hospital Ward up to the culvert on Kabarasthan Road.

NO. 31. MOTIBAGH WARD.

North.—Along the southern limits of Kamptee Road north-eastwards from the Motibagh Road up to new Jumma Talao Road (Panchpaoli Housing Accommodation Scheme).

South.—Northern boundary of Mayo Hospital Ward; further along the western and northern boundary of Bhankheda Ward.

East.—Along the eastern limits of new Jumma Talao Road southwards from Kamptee Road up to new Orange Market Road; then along the northern limits of Orange Market Road eastwards up to Panchpaoli Road; then along the eastern limits of Panchpaoli Road; southwards up to southern fencing of B. N. Railway (Calcutta Line).

West.—Along the eastern limits of Motibagh Road southwards from Kamptee Road up to southern fencing of B. N. Railway.

NO. 32. PANCHPAOLI WARD.

North.—Along the southern limits of Kamptee Road eastwards from New Jumma Talao Road (Panchpaoli Housing Accommodation Scheme) up to New Lalganj Road.

South.—Northern boundary of Jagnath Mandir Ward.

East.—Western boundary of Mehadibagh Ward between Kamptee Road and B. N. Railway (Calcutta Line).

West.—Eastern boundary of Motibagh Ward.

NO. 33. INDORA WARD

North.—Along the northern boundary of village Takli eastwards from the western fencing of G. I. P. Railway (Itarsi Line) up to the junction of villages Takli, Bhokara and Nara; then north-eastwards along the western boundary of village Nara up to the junction of villages Nara, Bhokara and Panjara; then eastwards along the northern boundary of village Nara up to the junction of villages Nara, Korahdi, and Khasala then southwards along the eastern boundary of village Nara up to the junction of villages Nara, Khasala and Nari; then eastwards and south-eastwards along the northern boundary of village Nari up to the junction of villages Nari, Kosari and Wanjara; then northwards and eastwards along the western and northern boundary of village Wanjara up to Kamptee Road.

South.—Along the northern limits of Cemetery Road eastwards from western fencing of G. I. P. Railway (Itarsi Line) up to Christian Cemetery; then eastwards along the northern limits of the same new road through the Refugee Colony up to New Indora Road; then southwards along the eastern limits of New Indora Road up to Indora Primary School; then westwards along the southern limits of North Indora Road up to West Central Road; then southwards along the eastern limits of West Central Road up to South Indora Road near public latrine; then eastwards along the northern limits of South Indora Road up to Kamptee Road.

East.—Along the southern limits of Kamptee Road southwards from the northern boundary of village Wanjara up to South Indora Road.

West.—Along the western fencing of G. I. P. Railway (Itarsi Line) from the northern boundary of village Takli up to Cemetery Road.

NO. 34. NEW COLONY WARD.

North.—Southern boundary of Indora Ward between G. I. P. Railway (Itarsi Line) and New Indora Road.

South.—Along the southern limits of Kamptee Road eastwards from the Western fencing of G. I. P. Railway (Itarsi Line) up to the junction of South Indora Basti Road.

East.—Southern boundary of Indora Ward from the junction of Cemetery Road and New Indora Road up to Kamptee Road.

West.—Along the northern limits of Cemetery Road westwards, southwards and south-westwards from the western fencing of G. I. P.

Railway (Itarsi Line) up to Chhindwara Road; then along the northern limits of Naya Basti Chaoni Road south-eastwards up to Sadar-Kamptee Road; further along the northern limits of Sadar-Kamptee Road eastwards up to western fencing of G. I. P. Railway; further along the western fencing of G. I. P. Railway southwards upto Kamptee Road.

NO. 35. CHAONI WARD

North.—Along the northern boundaries of villages Gorewara and Takli eastwards from the junction of villages Gorewara, Gondhani and Pittesur up to the western fencing of G. I. P. Railway (Itarsi Line).

South.—Along the northern limits of Katol Road eastwards from the point it crosses western boundary of village Borgaon up to Chhindwara Road; then northwards along the western boundary of Chhindwara Road up to Cemetery Road; further along the western boundary of New Colony Ward.

East.—Western boundary of Indora Ward.

West.—Along the western boundary of village Gorewara southwards from the junction of villages Gorewara, Gondhani and Pittesur up to the point it meets Khasra Nos. 1 and 123-124; then eastwards southwards and again westwards along the eastern boundary of Gorewara Tank up to the junction of villages Gorewara and Borgaon; further southwards along the western boundary of village Borgaon up to Katol Road.

NO. 36. GADDIGUDAM WARD.

North.—Southern boundary of New Colony Ward between G. I. P. Railway (Itarsi Line) and Motibag Road; further along the southern limits of Kamptee Road westwards up to St. John High School Road.

South.—Along the northern limits of Khalasi Lines Basti Road (Lala's Garden) from the St. John High School Road eastwards, southwards and again eastwards up to Motibag Basti Road.

East.—Western boundary of Motibag Ward between Kamptee Road and B. N. Railway, further along eastern fencing of B. N. Railway up to the point where it meets the northern fencing of Caltex Oil Depot then westwards in straight line up to south-east corner of the compound wall of St. John High School; then westwards up to the eastern edge of Shiva Temple; further southwards along the eastern limits of Motibag Basti Road up to Khalasi Lines Basti Road.

West.—Along the eastern limits of St. John High School Road southwards from Kamptee Road up to south-west corner of the compound wall of St. John High School.

NO 37. KHALASI LINES WARD (MOHAN NAGAR WARD)

North.—Western boundary of New Colony Ward between Chhindwara Road and Western fencing of G. I. P. Railway (Itarsi Line); further along the western and southern boundaries of Gaddigudam Ward.

South.—Northern boundary of Sitabuldi Ward; then southwards along western fencing of G. I. P. Railway up to railway bridge; further eastwards along the northern limits of Subhash Chandra Road up to eastern fencing of G. I. P. Railway.

East.—Along the eastern fencing of G. I. P. Railway southwards from the north-east corner of Caltex Oil Depot up to Subhash Chandra Road.

West.—Along the eastern limits of Chhindwara Road southwards from Nayabasti-Chaoni Road up to the junction of Katol Road and Residency Road; then southwards along the eastern limits of Residency Road up to the junction of Jail Road near Circuit House; further along the eastern limits of Jail Road southwards up to Ansari Road.

NO. 38. SADAR BAZAR WARD

North.—Along the northern limits of Katol Road eastwards from the Tiger Gap Road up to Chhindwara Road.

South.—Along the northern limits of North Telankheri Road eastwards from the Tiger Gap Road up to the junction of Residency Road and Jail Road.

East.—Along the eastern limits of Residency Road southwards from the junction of Chhindwara Road and Katol Road up to the junction of North Telankheri Road and Jail Road.

West.—Along eastern limits of Tiger Gap Road southwards from Katol Road up to North Telankheri Road.

NO. 39. CIVIL LINES WARD.

North.—Southern boundary of Chaoni Ward between western limits of village Borgaon and Tiger Gap Road.

South.—Along the northern limits of Amravati Road eastwards from the western boundary of village Kachimet up to Jail Road.

East.—Along the eastern and southern boundaries of Sadar Bazar Ward up to Jail Road; then along the eastern limits of Jail Road southwards up to Amravati Road.

West.—Along the western boundary of village Borgaon southwards from Katol Road up to the junction of villages Borgaon, Hazaripahad and Bodhala; then along the northern boundary of village Hazaripahad and Dhaba up to the junction of villages Dhaba, Lawa and Wadi; then southwards along the western and southern boundaries of village Dhabha and further along the southern boundary of village Dhaba and the western boundary of village Kachimet up to Amravati Road.

NO. 40. DHARAMPETH WARD.

North.—Southern boundary of Civil Lines Ward between Technological Institute Road and Jail Road.

South.—Along the northern limits of North Ambajhari Road eastwards from the junction with West High Court Road up to Jail Road.

East.—Along the eastern limits of Jail Road southwards from Amravati Road up to North Ambajhari Road.

West.—Along the eastern limits of Technological Institute Road southwards from Amravati Road up to Gokulpeth Road; then eastwards along the northern limits of Gokulpeth Road up to West High Court Road; then along the eastern limits of West High Court Road southwards up to North Ambajhari Road.

NO. 41. RAMDASPETH WARD.

North.—Southern boundary of Civil Lines Ward between western boundary of Village Kachimet and Technological Institute Road; further along the western and southern boundaries of Dharampeth Ward.

South.—Along the northern limits of Hingna Road eastwards from the western boundary of village Jaitala up to South Ambajhari Road eastwards up to Jail Road.

East.—Along the eastern limits of Jail Road southwards from North Ambajhari Road up to South Ambajhari Road.

West.—Along the western boundary of village Kachimet southward from Amravati Road up to the junction of villages Kachimet, Sonegaon-sim and Wadi; then westwards along the northern boundary of village Sonegaon-sim up to the point it meets the wire fencing of Ambajhari Catchment area: further south-westwards and southwards along the

same wire fencing up to the point meets the southern boundary of village Sonagaon-sim, then eastwards along the southern boundary of village Sonagaon-sim up to the junction of villages Sonagaon-sim, Takli and Digdoh; then southwards along the western boundary of village Takli up to the junction of villages Takli, Jaitala and Digdoh; further along the western boundary of village Jaitala up to the point it meets Hingana Road.

NO. 42. KHAMLA WARD.

North.—Southern boundary of Ramdaspath Ward.

South.—Along the southern boundary of village Shiwangaon eastwards from the junction of villages Shiwangaon, Isasani and Telhara up to the junction of villages Kalkuhi, Shiwangaon and Chichbhuan; then southwards along the western boundary of village Chichbhuan up to the junction of villages Chichbhuan, Kalkuhi and khapri; further eastwards along the southern boundary of village Chichbhuan up to Wardha Road.

East.—Along the eastern limits of Wardha Road southwards from South Ambajhari Road up to the point it crosses the southern boundary of village Chichbhuan.

West.—Along the western boundary of village Jaitala southwards from Hingana Road up to the junction of villages Jaitala, Digdoh and Shiwangaon then along the western boundary of village Shiwangaon southwards up to the junction of villages Shiwangaon Isasani and Talhara.

NOTIFICATION NO. 230-1965-M-XIII DATED THE 15TH JANUARY 1952.

Rules for the preparation of Electoral Rolls for the wards and Trade Union Special Constituency in the City of Nagpur.

[Under Section 10]

1. (1) The Chief Executive Officer shall, unless otherwise directed by the state Government, start the preparation of an electoral roll for each of the wards into which the city is divided and for the Trade Union special constituency created under section 9, six months before the date on which the term of the Corporation is due to expire.

(2) Every such roll shall contain the names of all persons who appear to be entitled to vote in the ward or special constituency for which the roll is under preparation.

2. (1) The electoral roll shall show the name, father's name or husband's name, profession, age, address and serial number of the elector.

(2) The Chief Executive Officer shall cause a sufficient number of copies of the electoral roll to be prepared in such manner as he considers convenient.

(3) Each candidate for election in a ward or special constituency shall be entitled to purchase from the Chief Executive Officer at a fair price one copy of the electoral roll for that ward or special constituency.

3. As soon as the electoral roll for a ward or special constituency is ready but not later than four months prior to the date of election, the Chief Executive Officer shall—

(a) publish the same at the following places:—

(i) at the office of the Corporation;

(ii) in the case of wards at such places as he thinks proper, in the ward to which it relates;

(iii) in the case of special constituencies the relevant electoral rolls at the office of the Registrar, Trade Unions; and

(b) cause a proclamation to be made in each ward and at each of the offices mentioned in sub-rule (a) (iii) above in such a manner as he deems fit that the electoral roll for that ward or special Constituency, as the case may be, has been published and can be inspected at the places mentioned in the proclamation.

4. (1) To the copies of the electoral roll a notice shall be affixed intimating that any person whose name is not in the roll or any person whose name is in the roll and who objects to the inclusion of the name of any other person therein may prefer a claim or an objection in the manner and within the time specified below to the Chief Executive Officer.

(2) Such claim or objection shall be in writing and shall be delivered by hand or sent by registered post so as to reach the Chief Executive Officer within one month from the date on which the roll was published. It shall be signed and verified by the claimant or objector in the manner provided for the signing and verification of pleadings in the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.

(3) Such claim or objection shall specify the grounds on which the right of any person to be entered in the roll is asserted or denied, the evidence which the claimant or objector intends to bring, the name and the address of the claimant or objector, his number, if any, in the electoral roll, and in the case of an objection the name, address and number in the electoral roll of the person to whose entry objection is taken.

(4) A claim or objection not lodged in the manner and within the period herein prescribed or by a person not entitled to lodge the same, shall be rejected. The order of rejection shall be final and no revision against it shall lie to any authority whatsoever.

5. (1) On receipt of a claim or objection lodged in the manner herein prescribed and by a person entitled to lodge such claim or objection, the Chief Executive Officer shall fix a date and place for hearing the same and shall give notice of such date and place to the claimant or objector. Where objection is taken to the entry of the name of any person in the electoral roll a copy of the objection with a notice of the date and place of hearing shall be sent to such person. A copy of the claim or objection stating the date and place fixed for hearing shall be placed on the Corporation Office Notice-board. The notice issued under this sub-rule shall require the parties concerned to produce on the date fixed for hearing any evidence, oral or documentary, on which they rely.

(2) Where any copy or notice is to be sent under sub-rule (1) such copy of notice shall be sent by registered post to the claimant or objector to the address given in the claim or objection and to the persons objected to, the address given in the electoral roll. A copy of notice so sent shall be deemed to have been duly served.

(3) After hearing the evidence, if any, adduced on behalf of the parties and after such further inquiry as he may deem necessary, the
